The North Shore Women's Centre is a non-profit organization that has been advocating for the safety, wellbeing, and status of women, girls, and gender-diverse individuals on the North Shore since 1973.

Through our wide range of free programs and services, we work to provide vital community support and connection for women. Our work seeks to end gender-based violence, intimate partner violence, and the feminization of poverty, by acting as a catalyst for change. We have been dedicated to improving the lives of women in our community for more than 50 years.

Our impact

We have over 9,000 community service contacts annually and provide support to a diverse group of women, girls, and gender-variant individuals on the North Shore. In recent years, we have seen an immense increase in need for our programming, which we are making great efforts to accommodate as a small, grassroots organization. All of our programs and services are free of cost. Our portfolio includes:

- A fully staffed drop-in resource centre, open for 20 hours per week, with a computer lab, laundry facilities, lending library, and more
- A Health and Wellness Program, including wellness appointments, a support group, exercise classes, and active living support
- Support Groups, in areas including Separation, Single Moms', Parenting (in Farsi), and Health and Wellness for women with chronic health concerns
- Technological Support, including one-on-one Basic Computer Training and Tech Support
- Young Women's Empowerment, including free summer camps and after-school groups
- Sexual assault and intimate partner violence prevention, including Flip The Script with EAAA™, an
 evidence-based sexual assault prevention training, the North Shore Violence Against Women in
 Relationships Committee (NS VAWIR), and the Sexual Assault Prevention in Bars and Restaurants
 Pilot Program
- Family Law support, including a free clinic and law advocate appointments

International Women's Day Celebration and Benefit

The North Shore Women's Centre's International Women's Day Celebration and Benefit is our vibrant and intimate annual fundraising event, which attracts between 100 and 150 socially-interested community members and allies each year. While a grassroots celebration, the benefit is our largest annual fundraising event, and is made possible thanks to the support of our donors, staff, and volunteers.

Attendee demographics include approximately 70% women and 30% men, ranging in age from 30-65, most of whom are residents or involved in the North Shore community (North Vancouver, West Vancouver, and the Sea to Sky Corridoor). Attendees are often local business owners, residents, political and media figures, and other highly-engaged community members.

The event is an evening of sharing and socializing over delicious food, with features such as a silent auction, presentations about the North Shore Women's Centre's work in the community, and a cash bar. The proceeds of this event go directly towards our work with women, girls, and gender-diverse individuals on the North Shore, and are a crucial element of our annual funding. This fundraiser makes a direct impact in the lives of our clients, and is a large part of how we are able to offer our extensive range of more than a dozen programs and services completely free of cost to all participants.

Sponsorships

Sponsorships are ways that individuals, households, and businesses can show their support for local charities and non-profits, give back to the community, and showcase their goals and values.

Event sponsorships of any dollar amount are a partnership, where funds are contributed to our event in exchange for acknowledgement and other **advantages**. The CRA defines advantages as "property, services, compensation, or other benefits that a person is entitled to receive in relation to the gift." NSWC Event Sponsorship perks (advantages) include advertisement in the form of various acknowledgements, and other benefits such as event tickets depending on tier level.

This exchange means sponsorships are **not eligible** for tax receipts according to CRA guidelines.
